

Recommended by Helmut – Ausilk Silky Terrier breeder!

What can you do to prevent cane toads invade your enclosed backyard? Or Dog enclosed area.

- Use some shade cloth about 60 - 90 cm in height
- Dig the shade cloth about 10 cm into the ground so that the toads can't dig themselves underneath.
- Bury 2 to 3 large plastic buckets (25 liter) with lids on the outside of your backyards fence line leaving them stick out about 5 cm above the ground. Fill the buckets with 1/5 of water, place a solar led light next to the bucket to attract insects, by doing this the toads will also be attracted and then fall into the bucket. When the toads are in the bucket they cannot get out again. The next morning you can take the toads out of the bucket with old tongs and dispose of them.
- DO NOT forget to close the bucket during the day so your dog does not fall into it.
